## **MAHB – LSF HANDBALL AND LANGUAGE CAMPS** **Notes for participants born in 1993/1994/1995/1996/1997/1998/1999 – July 2010**

### **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES**

- If you arrive by plane or train, you should arrive in Montpellier after 14.00. Please supply us with full travel details (times, train/flight numbers). Students arriving at Montpellier railway station should go outside the 'Relay' shop on the first floor, where our staff will be waiting for them.
- If you come by car, you should arrive at the CREPS between 16.00 and 16.30 (2 Avenue Charles Flahault, 34000 Montpellier, next to Stade Philippidès).

**You MUST arrive in Montpellier after 14.00 and before 16.30 on Monday 19 July 2010, and leave before 10.00 on Sunday 01 August 2010.**

**These times must be respected. If not, an extra fee of 20 € will be charged to cover the cost of supervision of your child.**

### **ACCOMMODATION AND FACILITIES**

You are accommodated at the 'CREPS de Montpellier' in twin rooms, with 4 participants sharing one bathroom.

Each room has a wardrobe.

Sheets, bedcovers and pillows are provided, but you must bring your own towels.

You will be able to make use of extra space, which can be locked, during your stay.

**The keys are magnetic, all lost or damaged keys must be paid for by the participant (20€).**





Staying at the CREPS, you will have access to all the facilities on the site, subject to their availability.

As all the facilities are of professional standard, you should respect the CREPS rules and regulations, which will be given to you at the start of the camp.

**All repairs, as a result of damage caused to the facilities, must be paid for in full (upon presentation of the invoice).**

## MEALS

Breakfast and dinner will be eaten in the restaurant of the CREPS; lunch will be organized according to the afternoon activity programme. Please inform us of any specific requests/diets (vegetarians, no pork,...).

It is possible, for reasons of organisation, that a cold lunch may be served.

As a general rule, the meals are balanced, adapted to the participants and include :

- Buffet of starters
- Hot dish (self-service) with one vegetable / one starchy food / one meat (white or red) or one fish
- One cheese
- One yoghurt
- One dessert or one fruit.

The participants also have snacks mid-morning and mid-afternoon.

A bottle of water is provided each day.



## **INSURANCE & MONEY**

You should send us a copy of your personal liability insurance, as well as a copy of your identity card/passport and valid social security cover, before the beginning of the camp. For students from EU countries, it is advisable to obtain a European Health Insurance Card from your local social security office before travelling. Hospital treatment for an accident or emergency is normally payable. Non-urgent treatment can be obtained through a local doctor, and again this is payable. You should also send us a Doctor's Certificate confirming your suitability to play handball, and to take part in group activities (dated less than one month before the start of the camp) and a photocopy of your Handball Club registration (if you are a registered player in a club); as well as a certificate confirming that you can swim 50m, and a French 'Fiche de liaison sanitaire' (dated less than one month before the beginning of the camp, LSF will send this to you about 6 weeks before the camp start date).

You should bring pocket money for incidentals (drinks, ice-creams, souvenirs, gifts...)- the exact amount is left to your discretion, but around 60 € per week seems reasonable. **MAHB-LSF cannot be held responsible in any way for loss of or damage to personal items during your stay.**

## **HANDBALL COACHING SESSIONS**

The handball coaching sessions are taken by fully-qualified coaches from MAHB.

There are 2 coaches for 22 players.

2 groups will be formed (according to the number of participants)

- -12 / -14 : players born in 1996 to 1999
- -16 / -18 : players born in 1993 to 1995.

You should bring four full kits (shirt/T-shirt, shorts, socks, towel, as well as **indoor and outdoor sports shoes**).

The rest of the kit is provided (balls, bibs).

Each group (a maximum of 22 players per group) has at least 5 sessions of handball coaching during the week (1H30 per session). Other timeslots are given over to watching video recordings of the sessions, watching matches or training sessions of the MAHB professional team, taking part in handball and sandball tournaments.

For the other activities, we will send you later a list of kit and equipment to bring with you.

## **LANGUAGE LESSONS**

9 x 90 minutes of language lessons (French or English, you choose) in the two weeks, ie 13.5 hours in total.

You will first take a level test (written and oral). The teachers are all qualified and native-speakers; the maximum number of students per class is 11. The language lessons mainly focus on communication (oral expression and comprehension), often with a link to sport.

## **ACTIVITY PROGRAMME**

You can consult the sample activity programme. Please do not forget to bring swimming trunks and a bathcap for the swimming pool ('boxer'-type shorts are not allowed).

## **SUPERVISION**

The centre is registered with the French 'Ministère de la Jeunesse et des Sports' (Youth and Sports Ministry), and all the activities are supervised by fully-qualified staff.

## **FEES**

**1190 €** full-board with accommodation at the CREPS.
